It is common courtesy to drive in a **COUNTERCLOCKWISE direction** around the lake!

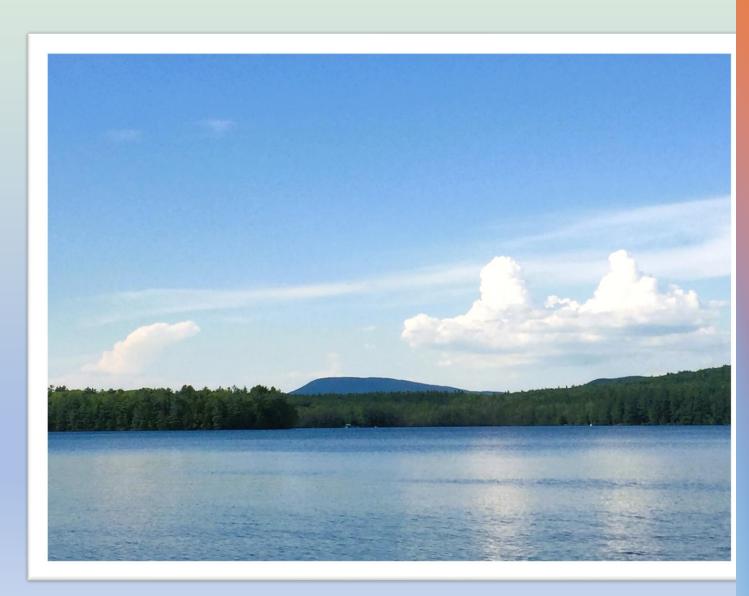

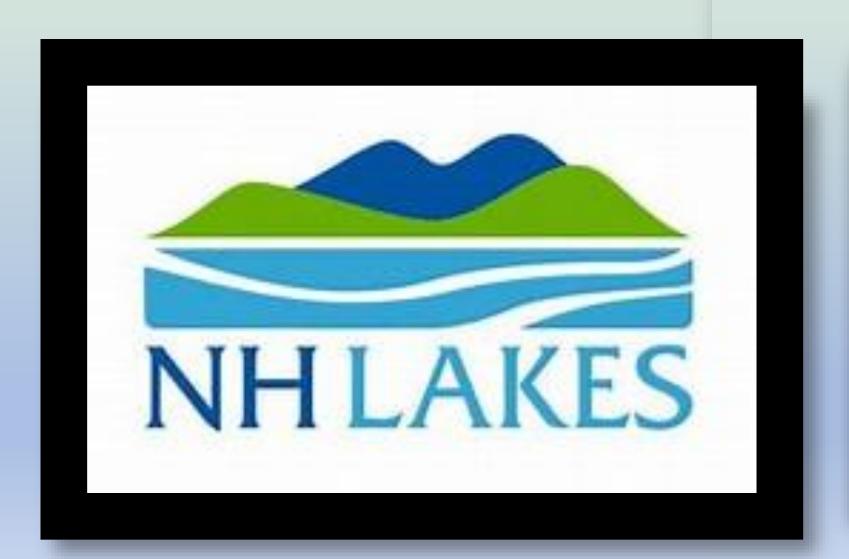

LOON DATA 2001 - 2025



Efforts to protect loon habitat and reduce human impact are crucial for maintaining healthy loon population (LPC)

Loons successfully nest, lay eggs and hatch chicks on Canaan Street Lake. Fledge rate of 48% required to maintain healthy loon population.

• 10 year fledge rate – 60%



• 7 year fledge rate – 50%

Chicks have been lost 3 times in last 7 years – 2 of those times were over the 4th of July weekend.

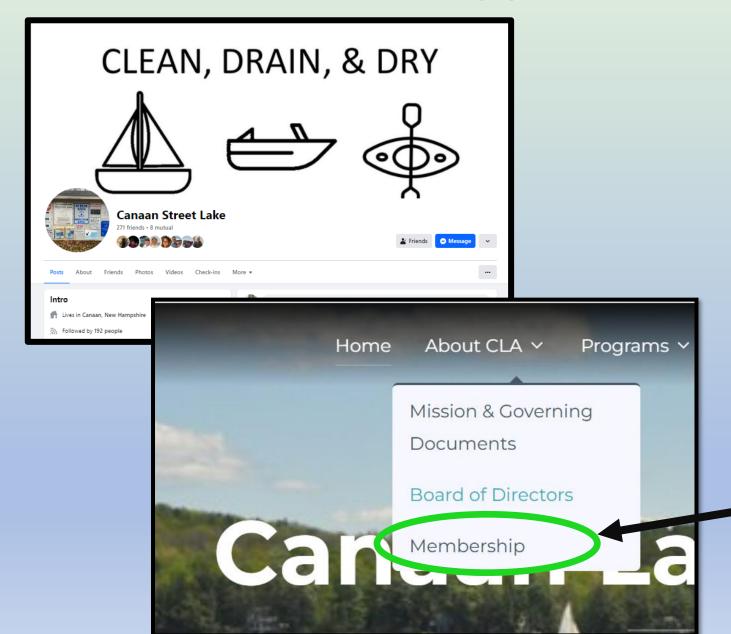

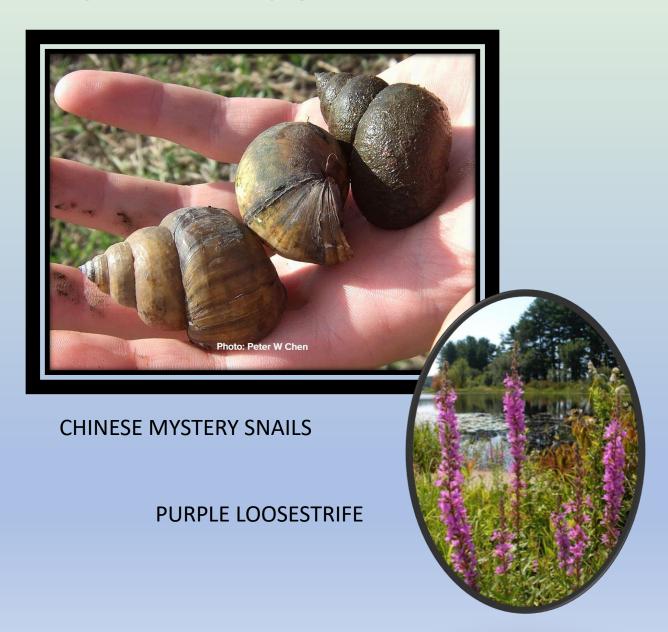

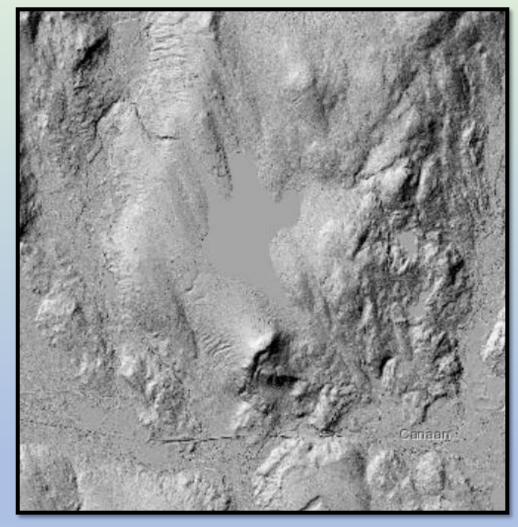
